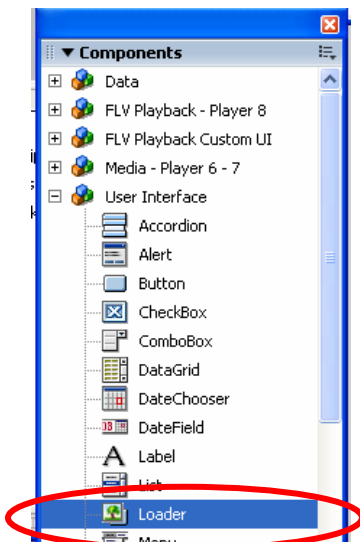
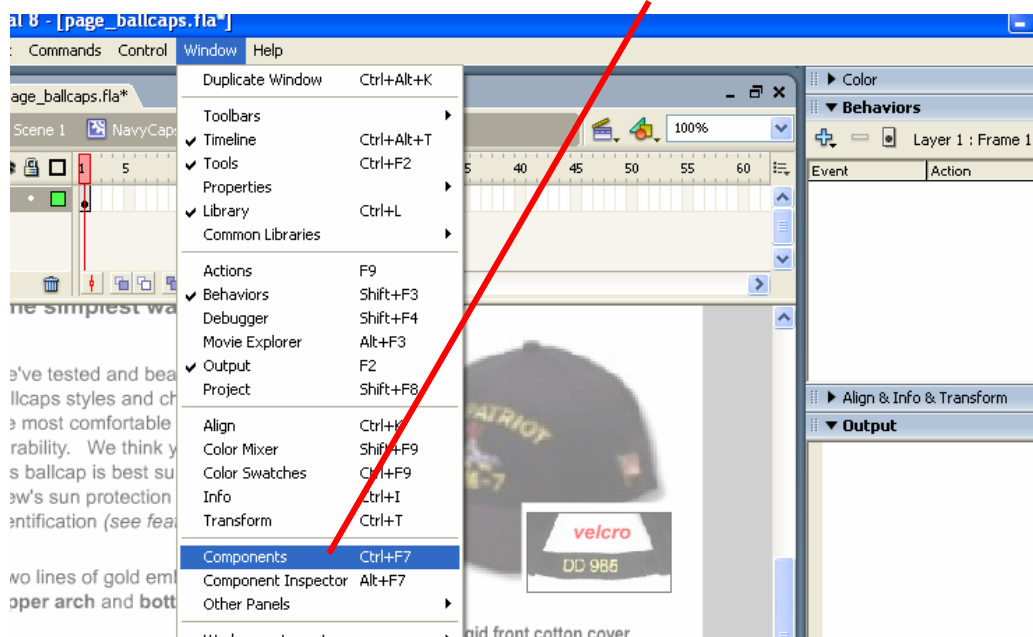


CREATE A PAYPAL SWF LOADER IN FLASH

The easiest way to set up a Flash site to accept PayPal using payment buttons!

First, create your desired SWF buttons in PayPal Flash Button Creator and save to your Flash Document's root folder. Then open your .FLA document in Flash.

Open the "Components" window inside the [Window Tab](#) or by clicking **Ctrl+F7**.



Next, open the User Interface tree and find the "Loader" component.

Left-Click and drag the loader component into your Flash document, in the spot where you wish the payment button to appear.

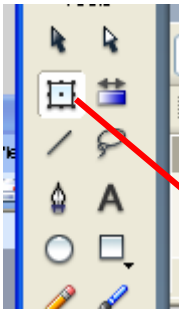

Select the Free Transform tool in your main toolbar.

Now click on the Loader item...
...and select the "Parameters" tab.

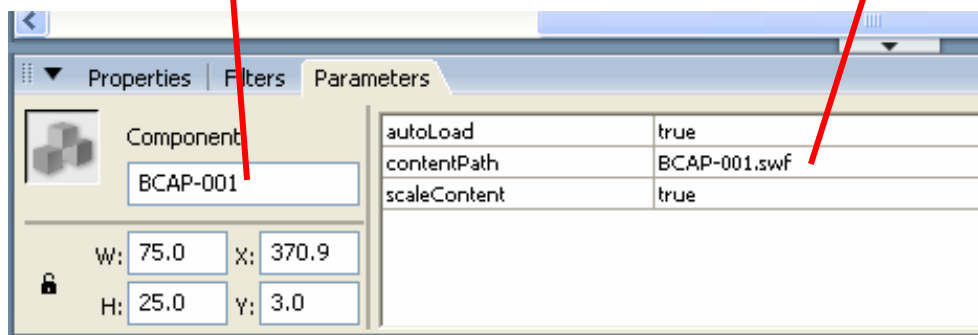

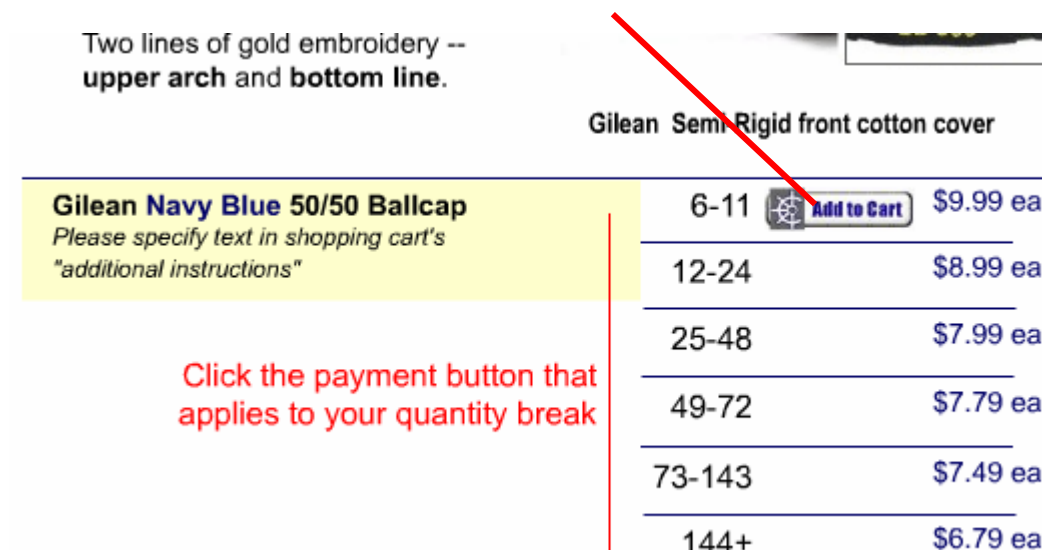

Actions

In the Parameters tab, type your button's filename in the Content Path. Also, rename the Component with your button name.



Now publish your site by clicking Shift+F12. When you preview your published SWF (Ctrl+Enter), you should see your new button on the page.



An excellent feature of using this process -- if you need to change your price or description, you need only create a new button in PayPal Flash Button Creator, overwrite the original button name (in this case, BCAP-001.swf) and publish it to the web. You don't even have to open Flash to update your items!

It may take some trial and error to get your buttons to show properly...once you get the hang of it, though, you can duplicate your loaders to save time.

Flash is a complicated program, so don't get discouraged if things don't work correctly the first time! Even experts make simple mistakes that prevent their buttons from working properly.

Some basic troubleshooting:

- Be sure your SWF payment buttons are in the same root folder as your main document.
- Publish your main document to update the document's viewable .swf file

- *You must Publish the Flash site in order for the PayPal buttons to function correctly. They will not work properly from inside Macromedia Flash. For some reason if you try it from inside Macromedia Flash, the buttons goto the PayPal homepage instead of the payment screen.*
